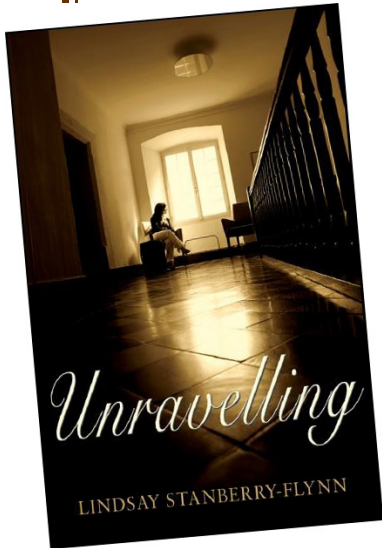


# *Unravelling* by Lindsay Stanberry-Flynn
